A reminder regarding the display of our American flag.

Section 8d of United States Code Title 4, Chapter 1.

Paragraph 6. Time and occasions for display

(a) It is the universal custom to display the flag only from sunrise to sunset on buildings and on stationary flagstaffs in the open. **However, when a patriotic effect is desired, the flag may be displayed 24 hours a day if properly illuminated during the hours of darkness.**

For those who wish to leave their American flag up overnight they need to comply with the laws of the land.

In our Rules and Regulations on Page7 "Windows". Before any work is started an ACR form must be submitted and approved by the BOD. In addition a Pasco County permit must be obtained and displayed in the work area .
