Is it the Early Bird or the Snow Bird? For all the snow birds that will be heading north here is a list of to do's before you leave. Bleach in the toilets bowls - Saran wrap the toilet bowl and tank – close lids & put a phone book or heavy weight on top of toilet seat - turn off the hot water tank circuit breaker lock all the windows & doors - put outdoor furniture away - table spoon of cooking oil in dish washer - check that all appliances are off -turn off refrigerator and put a towel or other prop in refrigerator doors – set the A/C at 830-850 - turn main water valve off give a year round resident a key to your unit or let management and associates know who to contact.
